Suggested Answer

1 I'd like to talk about the Formosan clouded leopard, a wild
2 animal from Taiwan that I find really fascinating. It's a beautiful big cat
3 with a spotted coat that looks like clouds, which is how it got its name.
4 Sadly, it's very rare and might even be extinct, but I still want to learn
5 more about it.

6 I've never actually seen a clouded leopard in the wild because
7 they're so hard to find. But last year, I saw a documentary about
8 Taiwan's wildlife at school in Taipei. The documentary showed
9 pictures of the leopard and talked about how it used to live in the
10 forests and mountains of Taiwan. Seeing those images made me
11 really curious because it's such a mysterious animal, and it's part of
12 my country's natural history.

13 I want to learn more about the Formosan clouded leopard
14 because it's a symbol of Taiwan's wildlife, and I feel proud to know we
15 have such a unique animal. Also, since it's so rare, I want to
16 understand why it's disappearing and if there's any chance it still
17 exists. I'm curious about its habits, like what it eats, how it hunts, and
18 how it lives in the wild. I also want to know if there are any efforts to
19 protect it or find out if some are still hiding in the forests.

20 Learning more about this animal could help me understand how
21 to protect Taiwan's environment better. I'd love to read studies or
22 maybe even visit a museum to see if they have information or exhibits
23 about the clouded leopard. It would be amazing to know more about

95.2 Part 3: Follow-up Questions and Answers

1. Why should we protect wild animals?

We should protect wild animals because they are an important part of nature. If one kind of animal disappears, it can affect the whole environment. For example, if bees die out, plants won't be pollinated, and people's food supply could be harmed. Wild animals also keep balance in nature, like lions controlling the number of zebras.

Besides, many animals are unique and beautiful, and losing them would mean losing part of our world's richness. Protecting wild animals is not only about saving them, but also about saving ourselves and making sure future generations can see them too.

我們為什麼要保護野生動物？

我們應該保護野生動物，因為它們是大自然的重要組成部分。如果一種動物消失，就會影響整個環境。例如，如果蜜蜂滅絕，植物就無法授粉，人類的食物供應也會受到影響。野生動物還能維持大自然的平衡，例如獅子可以控制斑馬的數量。此外，許多動物都是獨特而美麗的，失去它們意味著我們世界豐富資源的喪失。保護野生動物不僅是為了拯救它們，也是為了拯救我們自己，並確保子孫後代也能看到它們。

2. Why are some people more willing to protect wild animals than others?

Some people are more willing to protect wild animals because they feel a strong connection with nature. Maybe they grew up close to forests or loved animals since childhood, so they care more deeply. Others may understand better how important animals are to the environment, so they feel a responsibility to protect them. On the other hand, people who focus more on money or convenience may not care as much. For example, someone who wants to build factories in a forest may not think about animals. So, it really depends on people's values and life experiences.

為什麼有些人比其他人更願意保護野生動物？

1 **3. Do you think it's important to take children to the zoo to**

3 Yes, I think it's important, but it should be done in the right way. When
4 children see animals in real life, they become curious and want to
5 learn more. For example, reading about a tiger in a book is different
6 from actually watching it move and roar. However, zoos must take
7 good care of the animals, not just use them for money. If a zoo
8 focuses on education and protection, children can learn how amazing
9 animals are and why we should care for them. It can inspire children
10 to respect nature and grow into responsible adults.

11 **你認為帶孩子去動物園看動物很重要嗎？**

12 是的，我認為這很重要，但應該以正確的方式去做。當孩子在
13 現實生活中看到動物時，他們會變得好奇，想要了解更多。例
14 如，在書中閱讀關於老虎的知識與親眼目睹老虎的移動和咆哮
15 是不同的。然而，動物園必須好好照顧動物，而不僅僅是利用
16 它們賺錢。如果動物園注重教育和保護，孩子們就能了解到動

4. Why do some people attach more importance to protecting rare animals?

People pay more attention to rare animals because they are close to disappearing. For example, pandas or tigers are famous worldwide, and if they go extinct, we'll never see them again. Rare animals also symbolize cultural pride and natural beauty, so people feel they must save them. However, some people forget that common animals are also important for the environment. Protecting rare animals is easier to promote because they attract attention, but in reality, all animals, whether rare or not, play a role in the balance of nature. Still, rare animals often get more focus and care.

為什麼有些人更重視保護珍稀動物？

人們更加關注珍稀動物，因為它們瀕臨滅絕。例如，熊貓或老虎舉世聞名，如果它們滅絕，我們將再也見不到它們了。珍稀動物也像徵著文化自豪感和自然之美，因此人們覺得必須拯救它們。然而，有些人忘記了普通動物對環境也同樣重要。保護珍稀動物更容易宣傳，因為它們能吸引人們的注意。但實際上，所有動物，無論是否珍稀，都在自然平衡中發揮作用。儘管如此，珍稀動物往往得到更多的關注和照顧。

5. Should people educate children to protect wild animals?

Yes, definitely. Educating children about protecting wild animals is very important because they are the next generation. If children learn to respect animals when they are young, they will grow up with better habits and make responsible choices. For example, they can avoid buying products made from endangered animals or support eco-friendly actions. Schools and parents should teach children about why animals matter and how humans affect them. Fun activities, like nature trips or documentaries, can make learning more interesting. Once children understand the value of animals, they will naturally want to protect them in the future.

人們應該教育孩子保護野生動物嗎？

是的，絕對應該。教育孩子保護野生動物非常重要，因為他們是下一代。如果孩子從小就學會尊重動物，長大後就會養成更好的習慣，做出負責任的選擇。例如，他們可以避免購買由瀕危動物製成的產品，或支持環保行動。學校和家長應該教育孩子動物的重要性以及人類如何影響它們。有趣的活動，例如自然之旅或觀看紀錄片，可以讓學習更有趣。一旦孩子們理解了動物的價值，他們將來自然會想要保護它們。

6. Is it more important to protect wild animals or the environment?

Actually, the two are connected. If we don't protect the environment, wild animals won't survive. For example, if forests are cut down, animals like monkeys and birds lose their homes. If oceans are polluted, fish and turtles die. So, protecting the environment is like protecting the house, and protecting animals is like caring for the family inside the house. Both are important, but maybe starting with the environment makes more sense because it gives animals a safe place to live. In the end, protecting one naturally means protecting the other, since they cannot be separated.

1 I'd like to describe a striking advertisement that I've been
2 noticing a lot lately. It features Shohei Ohtani, the famous Japanese
3 baseball superstar who is incredibly popular across Asia, especially
4 here in Taiwan.

5 You can see this advertisement almost everywhere in Taipei. It's
6 prominently displayed on giant digital billboards outside the
7 department stores in the Xinyi District, and I also see it plastered on
8 the sides of public buses and inside MRT stations during my daily
9 commute.

10 The advertisement is a promotion for a luxury Japanese watch
11 brand called Seiko. In the ad, Ohtani is dressed in a sharp, elegant
12 suit rather than his usual baseball uniform, and he is looking
13 confidently into the camera while wearing a sleek, metallic watch. The
14 background is a minimalist black, which makes the watch stand out.
15 The main slogan of the campaign focuses on "precision and
16 performance," drawing a parallel between the absolute accuracy of
17 the watch and Ohtani's incredible precision and dedication on the
18 baseball field.

19 Personally, I think the advertisement is incredibly effective.
20 Usually, I find celebrity endorsements a bit artificial because it feels
21 like the famous person is just doing it for the money. However, in this
22 case, Ohtani has a reputation for being extremely disciplined, humble,
23 and hardworking, which perfectly matches the image of a high-quality,
24 precise timepiece. Every time I see it, it gives off a vibe of
25 professionalism and excellence. Even though I can't afford a luxury
26 watch right now, the commercial definitely succeeds in catching my
27 eye and making the brand feel aspirational and prestigious.

14 名人代言有點做作，因為感覺他們只是為了錢。然而，大谷翔
15 平以嚴謹自律、謙遜勤奮著稱，這與這款高品質、精準腕錶的
16 形像完美契合。每次看到它，我都感受到一種專業和卓越的氣
17 息。雖然我現在買不起奢華腕錶，但這則廣告確實成功吸引了
18 我的目光，讓我覺得這個品牌令人嚮往，也頗具聲望。

96.2 Part 3: Follow-up Questions and Answers

1. What are the advantages and disadvantages of advertisements?

The main advantage of advertisements is that they inform consumers about new products and special deals, helping people make better purchasing choices. For example, an ad can show you a new eco-friendly water bottle that keeps drinks cold all day. On the flip side, the disadvantage is that they can be incredibly intrusive and sometimes misleading. Many ads use exaggerated claims to manipulate people into buying things they don't actually need, which can lead to a lot of wasted money and consumer frustration.

廣告的優點和缺點是什麼？

廣告的主要優勢在於能夠告知消費者新產品和特價優惠訊息，幫助人們做出更明智的購買選擇。例如，廣告可以展示一款新型環保水瓶，能夠讓飲料一整天保持冰爽。但另一方面，廣告的缺點在於它們可能極具侵入性，有時甚至具有誤導性。許多廣告會誇大其詞，誘導人們購買他們實際上並不需要的東西，這會導致大量金錢浪費和消費者的不滿。

2. Why are many advertisements endorsed by celebrities?

Advertisers use celebrities because famous people bring an immediate sense of trust and familiarity to a brand. When fans see their favorite actor or singer using a product, they subconsciously associate that product with success, beauty, or cool factor. For instance, if a popular Taiwanese pop star endorses a specific brand of sports shoes in an commercial, teenagers are much more likely to buy those shoes because they want to emulate their idol. It is a powerful psychological tool that turns a celebrity's fan base into instant customers.

為什麼很多廣告都由名人代言？

廣告商之所以利用名人代言，是因為名人能迅速為品牌帶來信任感和熟悉感。當粉絲看到自己喜愛的演員或歌手使用某種產品時，他們會在潛意識裡將該產品與成功、美麗或酷炫聯繫起來。例如，如果一位台灣流行歌手在廣告中代言某個品牌的運動鞋，青少年更有可能購買這款鞋，因為他們想要效仿自己的偶像。這是一種強大的心理戰術，能將名人的粉絲群迅速轉化為消費者。

3. What is the most important factor in an advertisement?

In my opinion, the most critical factor is relevance to the audience. An ad can have a massive budget and amazing special effects, but if it doesn't solve a specific problem or connect with the viewer's needs, it will fail. For example, an advertisement for a food delivery app needs to clearly show how it saves time for busy office workers who don't have time to cook. If the message is clear and addresses what the consumer actually wants, the ad will be highly successful in driving sales.

廣告中最重要的因素是什麼？

我認為，最關鍵的因素是與受眾的相關性。廣告可以擁有巨額預算和酷炫特效，但如果它不能解決特定問題或滿足觀眾的需求，就會失敗。例如，外帶應用程式的廣告需要清楚地展示它如何為忙碌的上班族節省時間，讓他們不再需要做飯。如果訊息明確，並且滿足了消費者的實際需求，那麼這則廣告就能有效地促進銷售。

4. Why are some advertisements boring?

Ads usually become boring when they lack creativity and simply repeat the same old clichés without any unique storytelling. When a commercial just lists product features or uses a monotonous script, viewers will immediately tune out. For example, a laundry detergent ad that just shows a person washing a stained shirt over and over again is incredibly uninteresting because we have seen it a thousand times before. To be engaging, an ad needs to have humor, a surprising twist, or an emotional hook that captures attention.

為什麼有些廣告很無聊？

廣告如果缺乏創意，只是重複老套的橋段，缺乏獨特的敘事手法，就會變得枯燥乏味。如果廣告只是羅列產品功能或使用單調的腳本，觀眾會立刻失去興趣。例如，洗衣液廣告如果只是重複播放一個人洗一件沾滿污漬的襯衫的畫面，就會讓人覺得極其無聊，因為我們已經看過無數次了。要吸引觀眾，廣告需要有幽默感、出人意料的轉折或能夠抓住他們注意力的情感點。

5. Is advertising important for a company?

Yes, advertising is absolutely vital for any business to survive and grow in a competitive market. Without it, even the best product or service will fail simply because nobody knows it exists. Advertising builds brand awareness and helps a company stand out from its competitors. For instance, a new local cafe opening up in Taipei needs to run targeted social media ads to let neighbors know about their specialty coffee and opening discounts. It is the primary engine that drives new customers to a business.

廣告對公司重要嗎？

是的，廣告對於任何企業在競爭激烈的市場中生存和發展至關重要。沒有廣告，即使是最好的產品或服務也會失敗，因為根本沒人知道它的存在。廣告能夠提升品牌知名度，幫助企業在競爭對手中脫穎而出。例如，台北一家新開的咖啡館需要投放精準的社群媒體廣告，讓附近的居民了解他們的特色咖啡和開幕優惠。廣告是吸引新顧客的主要管道。

6. Which is more effective: online advertising or offline advertising?

I believe online advertising is generally much more effective nowadays because it allows companies to target a very specific audience and track their results in real time. For example, a company selling English learning textbooks can choose to show their online ads only to students who are actively searching for IELTS tips. Offline advertising, like billboards on the highway or flyers, is much more expensive and hits a random audience. However, offline ads are still useful for building a massive, trustworthy brand image in a local community.

線上廣告和線下廣告，哪一種比較有效？

我認為如今網路廣告總體上比傳統廣告更有效，因為它允許企業精準定位目標受眾並即時追蹤廣告成效。例如，一家銷售英語學習教材的公司可以選擇只向正在積極搜尋雅思技巧的學生展示其線上廣告。而像高速公路旁的廣告看板或傳單這樣的線下廣告則成本較高，且受眾群體較為隨機。然而，線下廣告對於在當地社區建立龐大且值得信賴的品牌形象仍然十分有用。
